Financial Policy: Payment and Insurance

Insurance Billing

As a courtesy, we will submit claims to your dental insurance provider for services typically covered under your plan. Please be aware that most insurance policies include deductibles, co-payments, and coverage limits. While routine preventative services are often fully covered, many plans provide partial coverage for surgical and restorative treatments. Due to the variety of insurance plans, we may not have access to the specific details of your coverage. However, we are happy to assist you in understanding and maximizing your benefits.

<u>Understanding Your Benefits</u>

To avoid any surprises, we recommend that you familiarize yourself with the terms of your insurance plan, including coverage details, deductibles, and co-pays.

Payment Expectations

At the time of service, we require payment for any portion of treatment not covered by your insurance, or a payment of 20% of the total cost if your insurance benefits cannot be determined. Any remaining balance that insurance does not cover will be billed to you directly. For patients without insurance (self-pay), payment is required at the time of service.

Payment Methods

We accept cash, checks, and all major credit cards. For patients needing extended payment options, we may offer monthly credit card payment plans.
